Who is the central figure of the Bible?

The central figure of the Bible is Jesus Christ, the hope of mankind.

John 5:39

You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me.

Teenagers and Children:

- This week we will look specifically about the life of Jesus Christ. Read together John 5:37-47.
- What point was Jesus trying to make to whom He was talking to? Keep in mind that his audience were those that considered themselves as high ranking Jews.
- Based on what Jesus said in this passage, is reading the Bible enough to cause them to become a Christian?
- What did Jesus say about man in this passage? Is man good?
- What did Jesus say about the Old Testament? Did Moses write about Jesus?
- Spend some time in prayer thanking God for protecting His Word, but also that the Word speaks of Jesus, our Saviour!
